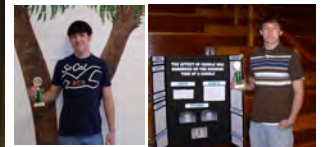

Science Fair Winners Head to State

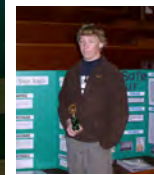
The WA Science Fair was held on February 24th. All of our students did a wonderful job on their projects. Eight students will be competing at the State Science Fair on April 14th.

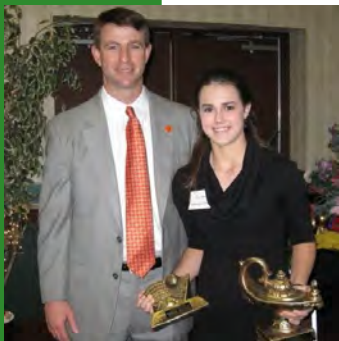
