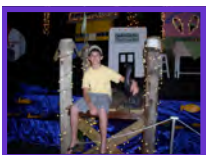
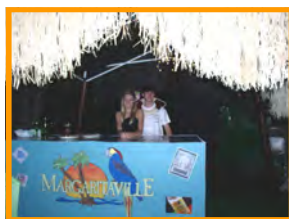
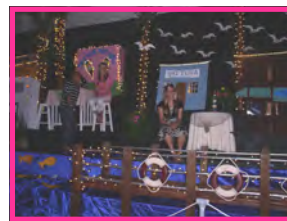
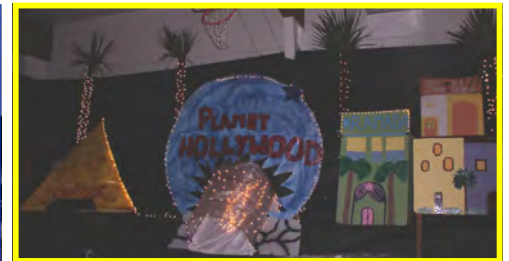
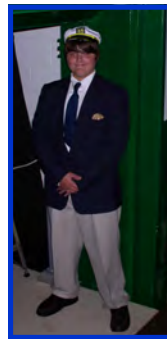
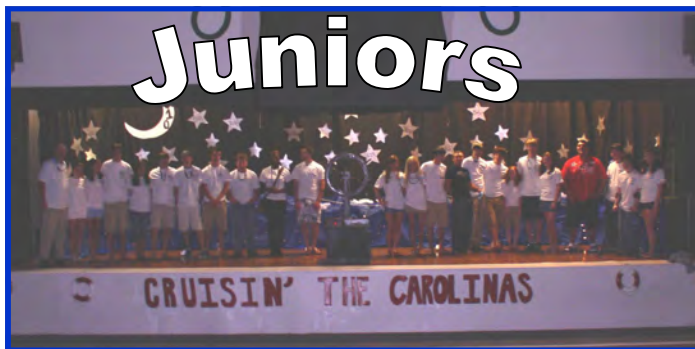
SCISA State Science Fair Winners
