

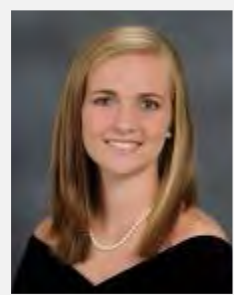

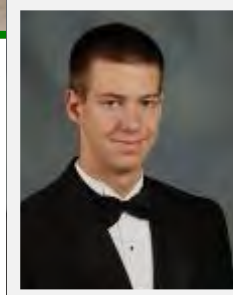

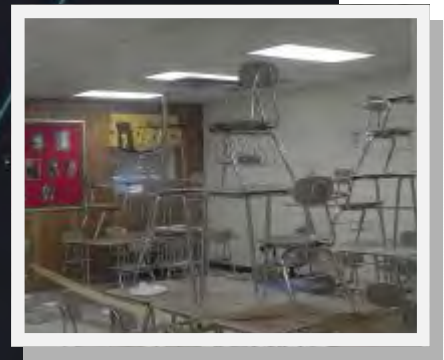


## Chapel Programs

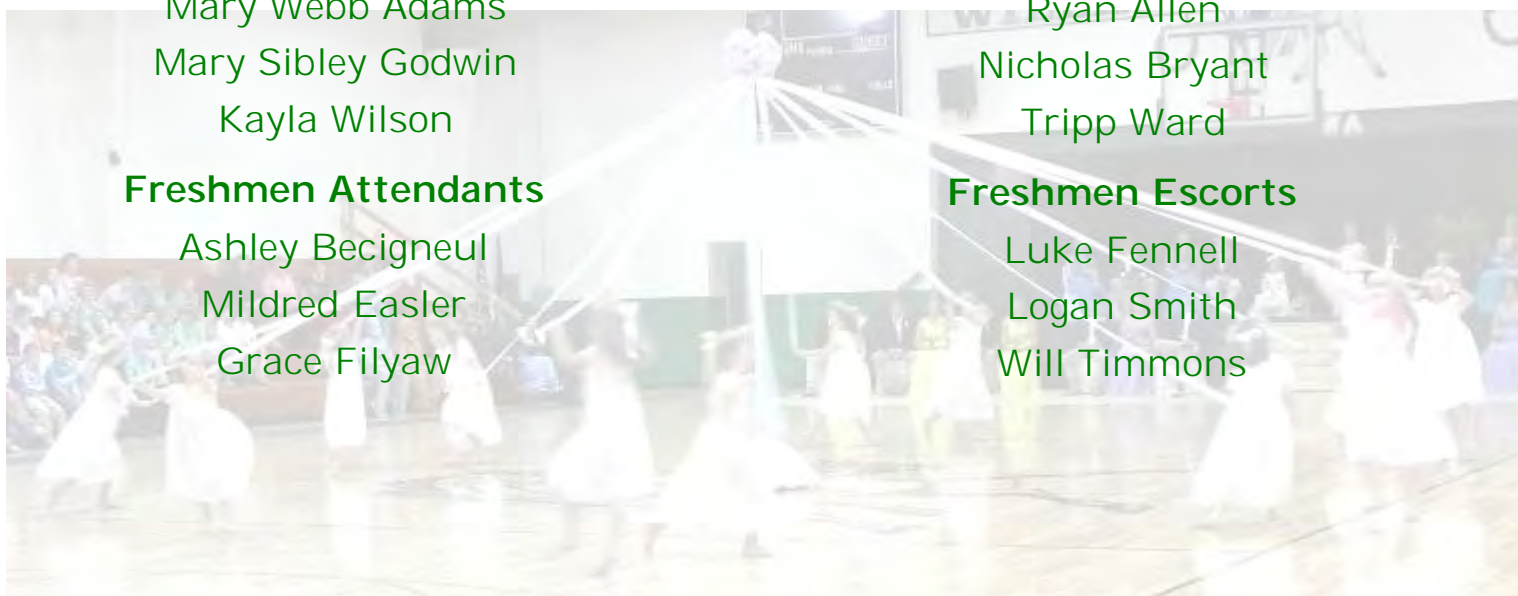
